What is IFLA NPSIG and IFLAcamp?

[World Library and Information Congress](#) (WLIC) is an annual international event organised every year in different locations in the world by IFLA (The International Federation of Library Associations and Institutions). After being held last year in Wrocław, Poland, [WLIC moved to Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia in 2018](#) ; in 2019, it will be held in Athens, Greece.

[New Professionals Special Interest Group](#) (NPSIG) is a small subdivision of a large IFLA association. Organised for the first time in 2011 in Finland, a small scale free unconference in the alternative format of a Camp is hosted prior to an IFLA congress: IFLAcamp is a participant driven light structured event which gives an opportunity to all library and information sector professionals, students and enthusiasts to be involved with the current "hot" themes in the field and to build up international connections.
